



Northern Cyprus seeks stronger economic cooperation with IsDB

Jeddah, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, 16.04.2017: The Republic of Northern Cyprus seeks stronger economic cooperation with the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) in the education sector and Awqaaf (endowments) development.
